## Cultural Caring for Country Approach

Moogji integrates traditional ecological knowledge with contemporary environmental management practices. Programs are designed to protect biodiversity while maintain cultural connections to Country and enabling Elders to transfer knowledge to younger generations.

## Core Capabilities

-  **Environmental Land Management**  
Weed detection, mapping, herbicide application, manual removal and biodiversity protection
-  **Fauna Monitoring & Control**  
Monitoring and control of feral pigs, foxes and deer including surveillance programs, trapping, ethical culling and bait stations
-  **Habitat Restoration**  
Revegetation, erosion control and riparian corridor restoration to improve ecosystem health
-  **Native Plant Nursery**  
Propagation and supply of indigenous tube stock and advanced native species for revegetation projects
-  **Environmental Monitoring**  
Camera monitoring, environmental data collection and ArcGIS spatial mapping for reporting
-  **Environmental Infrastructure**  
Track works, boardwalk construction and environmental protection infrastructure

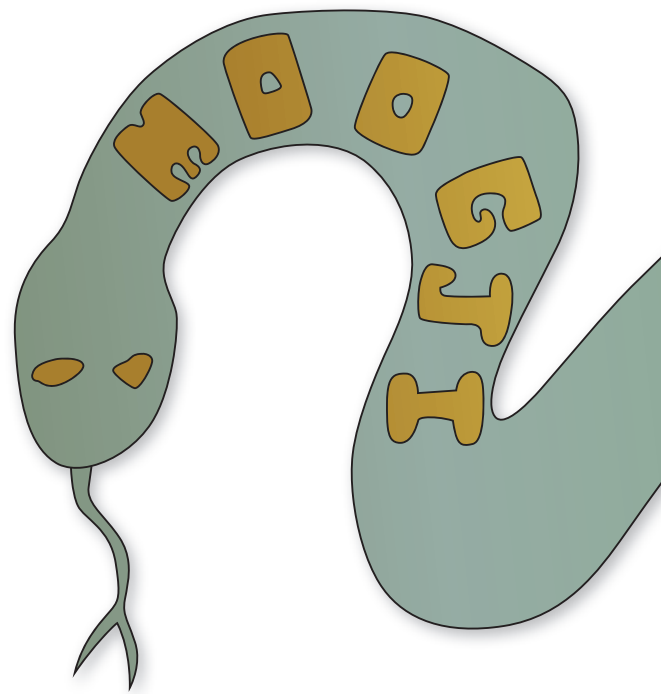

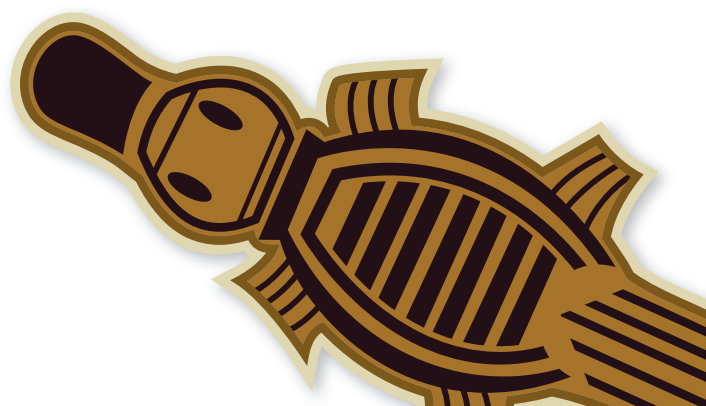
