

Statement of Commitment to Child Safety

Moogji is committed to promoting and protecting the safety and wellbeing of all children and young people, and we have zero tolerance for any form of abuse of children and young people.

As an Aboriginal Community Controlled Organisation (ACCO), we provide a welcome, inclusive and culturally safe environment where Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children and young people are safe and valued.

We believe that child safety is everyone's responsibility and this belief is embedded in the way we work, make decisions and engage with our community.

All Moogji Board members, employees and volunteers are required to conduct themselves in a manner consistent with a Child Safe organisation and share responsibility for the care and protection of children and young people and for reporting concerns about their safety and wellbeing.

We:

- Recognise the importance of cultural safety for our Aboriginal children and young people and are committed to ensuring their culture, identity, family and Community connections are respected and supported at all times.
- Want our children and young people to be safe, happy, empowered and able to participate in decisions that affect them.
- Have zero tolerance for child abuse, harm, neglect or exploitation.
- Are committed to creating environments where children and young people feel respected, listened to, included and protected.
- Support and encourage children, young people and their families to raise concerns, provide feedback and participate in improvement our services and programs.
